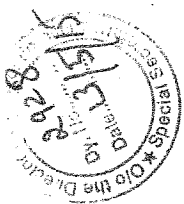


Sir,

I am directed to invite attention to this Ministry's notification of even number dated the 31st March 2008 (a copy of which was sent with Secretary (P)'s D. O. letter No. 1059/18/2002-AIS-III, dated the 3rd April, 2008) which, inter alia, provides that the health check-up is mandatory for all Indian Administrative Service Officers above the age of 40 and may be totally dispensed with for officers below the age of 40, except in case of medical incidents. As regards the Indian Police Service and Indian Forest Service, the annual health check-up is mandatory for all officers. The rules further provide that the format of the health check-up and the summary of medical report will be as circulated by the Cadre Controlling Authority, after consultation with Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

2. As regards the Indian Administrative Service Officers, a copy of the annual health check up format, which also includes the format of summary of medical report, is enclosed.

3. As regards the Indian Police Service and the Indian Forest Service officers, Ministry of Home Affairs and the Ministry of Environment & Forests are being requested to finalise the same in consultation with the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and circulate to all the State Government/UTs as well as to the Central Ministries/ Departments.
