

Minutes of the Meeting of the Screening Committee held on 15.12.2014 at 03.30 PM to prepare the "OFFER LIST" for DIGF/AIGF level posts under the Central Staffing Scheme of MoEF.

The Meeting of the Screening Committee for recommending names/ panel for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" for the posts at the level of Deputy Inspector General of Forests (DIGF) and Assistant Inspector General of Forests (AIGF) was held on 15.12.2014 in the chamber of ADGF(WL), Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Jor Bagh Road, New Delhi. Following were present in the meeting:

The Committee was assisted by Shri B.K. Singh, Director (IFS-I).

The Committee while considering the names for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" against the vacant/likely to fall vacant posts at the level of DIGF and AIGF under the CSS-MoEF Scheme dated 06.05.2011, took into account their Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs)/Performance Appraisal Reports (PARs) grading and other relevant records for ascertaining their suitability. Keeping in view the fewer applications received through proper channel against the available vacancies, the Committee unanimously decided to consider those applications also which were received only as advance copy on or before the receipt of last date of application subject to receipt of applications through proper channel on or before the meeting of the Central Forestry Establishment Board (CFEB). The Committee also fixed a bench mark of 35 as the minimum bench mark out of maximum 45 considering 05 APARs of officers for inclusion in the "Offer List" and also took into account the vigilance clearance status of officers.




