

Minutes of the Meeting of the Screening Committee held on 19.01.2017 at 11.00 AM to prepare the "OFFER LIST" for DIGF/AIGF level posts under the Central Staffing Scheme of MoEF&CC.

The Meeting of the Screening Committee for recommending names/panel for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" for the posts at the level of Deputy Inspector General of Forests (DIGF) and Assistant Inspector General of Forests (AIGF) was held on 19.01.2017 in the chamber of ADGF(FC), Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Jor Bagh Road, New Delhi. Following were present in the meeting:

- (i) Dr. Anil Kumar, ADGF(FC) - Chairperson
- (ii) Shri B.S. Bonal, ADGF(WL) - Member

The Committee was assisted by Shri Jerome Minz, DS(IFS) and Shri Abhijit Roy, US(IFS-I).

2. The Committee was apprised that for DIGF level posts, IFS officers of 1993-2001 with two years of overlap are eligible and for AIGF level posts, IFS officers of 2002-2010 with two years of overlap are eligible.

3. The Committee was apprised that in the vacancy circular dated 27.10.2016, it is also mentioned that as per provisions contained in para 4 of the Central Staffing Scheme of MoEF&CC dated 06.05.2011, in exceptional cases, where sufficient number of IFS officers are not available for the appointment to specific posts, the officers borne on the State Forest Service (SFS) whose names are included in the 'Select List' referred to in Regulation 7(3) of the IFS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1966, shall also be considered for selection for appointment. In case of posts in the North Eastern Region, the SFS officer who are yet to be included in the 'Select List' referred to above, shall also be considered. This provision will however be applicable for **DIGF/AIGF** level posts only.

4. The Committee considered all applications including advance copies. It was decided that in respect of advance copies, the application through proper channel should be received in the Ministry before the meeting of the Central Forestry Establishment Board (CFEB).

5. The Committee while considering the names for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" against the vacant/likely to fall vacant posts at the level of DIGF and AIGF under the Central Staffing Scheme of CSS-MoEF&CC, took into account their Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs)/Performance Appraisal Reports (PARs) grading and other relevant records for ascertaining their suitability.

6. While considering applicants for **DIGF level posts**, the Screening Committee recommended the following names for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" subject to vigilance clearance and conditions mentioned in the remarks column:-


