the post of Joint Secretary / equivalent at the Centre – regarding.


Sir,

I am to refer to inform that the Consolidated Empanelment Guidelines of the Department of Personnel & Training have been modified and as per modified guidelines, representations from the officers under consideration at the time initial assessment of the batch are required to represent against arbitrary downgrading by reviewing or accepting authority, mismatch between grading and pen picture, missing ACRs, assessment recorded for periods less than three months, assessment recorded long after due date etc.

2. Subsequently, copies of such representation, if any, along with the comments of the state Government are required to be forwarded to this Ministry. As such, the State Government is requested to clarify whether any officer of 2001 batch of IFS was given the aforesaid opportunity. It may also be informed whether any officer of 2001 batch of IFS belonging to your State/cadre is/was on foreign assignment/assignment equivalent to Rule 6.2(ii) of consolidated deputation guidelines dated 28.11.2007 during last 02 years.

3. The State Government is requested to kindly furnish the aforesaid information at the earliest for enabling this Ministry to take further action in this regard.
