

The undersigned is directed to refer to M/o Environment, Forest and Climate Change O.M. No. 12026/01/2019-IFS-I dated 11.09.2019 on the subject mentioned above and to say that under the Consolidated Deputation Guidelines for the All India Services issued by DoPT vide its letter No. 14017/33/2005-AIS(II)(Pt.I) dated 28.11.2007, 3 years 'Cooling off' is mandatory before an officer can be considered for another deputation. Therefore, it is not feasible, to consider the proposal for waiving the 'Cooling off' period in respect of Shri T. C. Nautiyal, IFoS(AGMUT:2002).


