Subject: Nomination from Indian Forest Service Officers for appointment to the post of Additional Director General of Forests in the Pay scale of Rs. 24050-650-26000/- on tenure deputation in the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to say that in terms of para 13(1) & (V) (A) of the Revised Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry circulated vide O.M. No. A.12011/1/2003-IFS-1 dated 9<sup>th</sup> May 2007, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India submitted a proposal to the Appointments Committee of Cabinet (ACC) for empanelment of suitable Indian Forest Service Officers for appointment to the post of Additional Director General of Forests in the pay scale of Rs. 24050-650-26000/- on tenure deputation based on the evaluation of their Annual Confidential Reports/Personal Appraisal Reports by the Screening Committee. The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet vide communication No. 9/27/2007-EO(SM-II) dated 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2008 has now approved the proposal for empanelment of the following Indian Forest Service officers to the post of Additional Director General of Forests in the Pay scale of Rs. 24050-650-26000/- on tenure deputation in the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, reckoned as the 'Central Deputation Reserve' of the Indian Forest Service :

2. Presently, the vacancy of ADGF level is available for the post of ADGF (Wild life), in the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, New Delhi.

3. The State Governments/UT Administration are requested to forward the nominations, in the enclosed format, of the willing officers from amongst the empanelled Indian Forest Service officers whose services can be spared for deputation with the Government of India. However, final selection of the empanelled officers will be subject to Central Vigilance Clearance. The Nomination should accompany by following documents / Certificates.

- State Vigilance Clearance and integrity Certificate:
- Attested photocopies of ACRs of each of the Nominee for the past ten years;
- Bio-data of the officers indicating the posts held throughout the career in a chronological order starting with the present position; and
- Details in the proforma (enclosed) duly certified by the prescribed authority in the State Government.


4. The Officers who have completed one spell of Central Deputation may be considered for a further spell of Central Deputation only after they have completed the stipulated cooling off period. It is certified that cooling off period is reckoned from the date the officer reports back to his/ her cadre on completion of earlier deputation tenure. The cooling off and other conditions of deputation will be as per consolidated deputation guidelines for All India Services, circulated vide DoPT circular No. 14017/33/2005-AIS(II)(Pt.I), dated 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2007.

5. Although in terms of Indian Forests Services (Cadre) rules, 1966 and other Service conditions governing the Indian Forest Service Officers, consent of IFS officers is neither necessary for nomination/appointment against Central Deputation Reserve posts, nor for their placement anywhere in the country, many a times, nomination of unwilling personnel would be a bottle-neck to the efficient management of the service. It is also noticed in this context that some of the State Cadre authorities do not consult/inform the officers concerned while recommending their names for empanelment. Many a times, this result in the empanelled officers expressing unwillingness to take up the central deputation appointment in spite of the fact that the deputation orders have been issued after a long selection process. If an officer selected for appointment fails to take up the central deputation assignment after the appointment is approved, he will attract a '5 year debarment' from central deputation including foreign deputation/ foreign training/ foreign assignment etc.

6. The State Cadre authority, etc., are requested to note that nominations unaccompanied with relevant documents/certificates, etc., will not be considered for inclusion in the offer list. The nomination forms complete in all respects must reach this Ministry latest by 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2008.

7. It is also requested that the Check List ( Annexure-II) must be read carefully before forwarding the nominations to this Ministry.


