

Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 13.8.2009, I am directed to say that the Competent Authority has upgraded some of the vacant posts w.e.f. 10th September, 2009 for which nominations of IFS officers were invited from the State Governments by 30th September, 2009.

2. As some of the vacant posts which were circulated earlier vide above referred Ministry's letter dated 13.8.2009 have been upgraded now. Since the eligibility criteria for these upgraded posts have changed and therefore it has been deiced to invite fresh nominations from IFS officers for appointment only against these upgraded vacant posts (Annexure-I). The eligible batches falling within zone of consideration for Chief Conservator of Forests level posts are 1981-86 and for Conservator of Forests level posts are 1987-92. The State Governments are requested to forward nominations, complete in all respects, along with Vigilance Clearance Report of the willing officers whose services can be spared, to the Under Secretary (IFS-I), Room No.511, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, New Delhi-110003 so as to reach this Ministry latest by 15th October, 2009.
