**Sub: Nominations of Indian Forest Service officers for appointment on tenure deputation basis against forestry posts covered under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry of Environment and Forests during 2009-10 - regarding.**

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Environment and Forests invites nominations of suitable IFS officers for appointments against available/likely to be available vacancies (annexure 1) at various levels under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry for the year 2009-10. The eligible batches falling within zone of consideration are for DG FSI 1977-80; for CCF level posts 1981-86, for CF level posts 1987-92; and for DCF level posts 1993-2002.

2. The State Governments are requested to forward the nominations of the willing officers who are clear from vigilance angle and whose services can be spared. However, final selection of the officers will be subject to the central vigilance clearance, their empanelment and for the levels of CCF and above approval of the ACC.

3 In terms of Indian Forest Service (Cadre) Rules, 1966 and other Service conditions governing the Indian Forest Service officers consent of IFS officer is neither necessary for nomination/appointment against Central Deputation Reserve posts, nor for his placement anywhere in the country. Many a times, however, appointment of unwilling person becomes a constraint to his efficient working. Further, some of the state governments do not consult /inform the officer concerned while forwarding his name for deputation. This might result in the selected officers expressing unwillingness to take up the appointments. Also, the deputation process usually takes 3-4 months to complete. Once an officer's name is forwarded, he should be relieved for the deputation post in case of his selection. If the officer selected fails to take up the assignment, he may attract a '5 year debarment' from central deputation and also from foreign deputation /foreign training/foreign assignment etc.

4. The nomination complete in all respect along with vigilance clearance report and concurrence of the state government should be sent to the Under Secretary (IFS I), Room No.511, Paryavaran Bhavan, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi-110003 so as to reach the
