

Minutes of the Meeting of Central Forestry Establishment Board held on 20.07.2011 to consider cases of DIGF/AIGF level posts covered under CSS-MoEF

The Meeting of the Central Forestry Establishment Board (CFEB) for recommending names/ panel to the posts at the level of Deputy Inspector General of Forests and Assistant Inspector General of Forests was held on 20.07. 2011 in the chambers of Secretary , Ministry of Environment & Forests in Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi.

The Board while considering the names, from the offer list of DIGF & AIGF level, for appointment against the vacant posts at the level of DIGF and AIGF in the Government of India took into account the range of experience of the applicants, their Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs) / Personal Appraisal Reports (PARs) and other relevant record for ascertaining their suitability for a particular post.

2. The Board also took note of the recommendation of the Screening Committee, constituted for "offer list" at IGF level and decided to consider those applicants, who are in the IGF "offer list" and also applied for DIGF level posts. It was decided that the available vacant vacancies at the level of DIGF be first filled by officers from eligible batches as per the vacancy circular. If the vacancies still remain vacant then 1987 batch can be considered for DIGF level posts also by inviting fresh applications by giving adequate time.

In case of post of Additional Professor, IGNFA, the committee observed that there are not sufficient number of applicants from 1988- 93 batches out of which a panel could be recommended therefore it is advised to re-circulate the vacancy to get more applicants by including willing officers from 1987 batch as well.

4. While considering the DIGF level posts at Delhi, the committee noted that Sh. Vivek Saxena, IFS(HR:91) is the only applicant, and it was decided to keep him in the Ministry itself against the consequential vacancy which may occur after the process of IGF selection is finalized.
