

Minutes of the Meeting of the Screening Committee held on 31.03.2015 at 10.30 A.M. to prepare the "OFFER LIST" for APCCF/IGF level posts under the Central Staffing Scheme of MoEF

The Meeting of the Screening Committee for recommending names/panel for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" for the posts at the level of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (APCCF) and Inspector General of Forests (IGF) was held on 31.03.2015 in the chamber of Director General of Forests & Special Secretary, Ministry of Environment and Forests, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi. 2. The Committee while considering the names for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" against the vacant/likely to fall vacant posts at the level of APCCF and IGF under the Central Staffing Scheme of MoEF, took into account their Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs)/Personal Appraisal Reports (PARs) grading and other relevant records as well as the following and other eligibility conditions notified for the purpose for ascertaining their suitability:

- (i) For APCCF level, IFS Officers of 1983-86 batch will be eligible and should have a minimum of 03 years of service left before superannuation as on 01.01.2015.
- (ii) For IGF level, IFS Officers of 1987-90 batch will be eligible and should have a minimum of 04 years of service left before superannuation as on 01.01.2015.
- (iii) Crucial date for determining cooling-off period is 01.01.2015 as notified.

3. The Screening Committee also set the following criteria for inclusion of officers in "OFFER LIST":

- (i) Vigilance Clearance Certificate including Annual Property Return.
- (ii) Out of 72 marks (maximum) considering 8 ACRs/PARs, qualifying benchmark of 62 marks was fixed.
- (iii) At least 3 ACRs/PARs from the cut-off year (2013-14) out of 05 years immediately preceding the cur-off should be available.

4. The Committee was apprised that in addition to the details of applications received which have been mentioned in the Annexure-II and Annexure-IV, four more applications (02 applications for the post of APCCF and 02 applications for the post of IGF) have been received before the meeting was held.

5. The Committee considered all application including advance copies. It was decided that in respect of advance copies, the application through proper channel should be received in the Ministry before the Selection Committee meeting.
