ORDER

WHEREAS the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forest Service was convened on 4.9.2009 and 25.11.2010 to consider the case for promotion of officers in the Joint AGMUT Cadre of IFS to various grades in the Cadre against the vacancies arose consequent on Review of the Cadre Strength notified by the Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India; vide Notification No. 16016/06/2008-AIS-II(A) dated 24.3.2009 [G.S.R 193 (E)]; as also against the resultant vacancies arose in the cadre on account of superannuation of the incumbents. The recommendations of the Committee as contained in its Minutes of the Meeting held on 4.9.2009 and 25.11.2010 was considered and with the approval of the competent authority; office orders dated 9.12.2009 and 13.12.2010; effecting promotion in various grades in the Joint AGMUT Cadre of IFS, were issued.

2. AND WHEREAS a disciplinary proceedings case was in progress against Shri C.D Singh, IFS (AGMUT: 87); on account of which vigilance clearance was withheld in his case and this fact was placed before the Committee. The Committee in its meeting held on 4.9.2009 and 25.11.2010 considered the case for promotion to the Grade of Chief Conservator of Forest and Non-functional up gradation in respect of Shri C.D Singh. The findings of the Committee regarding suitability of promotion to the grade of Chief Conservator of Forest and Non-functional up gradation in respect of Shri C.D Singh were, however, kept in sealed cover by the committee, in the light of Shri C.D Singh not being clear from vigilance angle on account of the then ongoing disciplinary proceedings.

3. AND WHEREAS the disciplinary proceeding initiated against Shri C.D Singh has finally been disposed off vide order No. 12011/03/2010-AVU dated 16.12.2010 wherein Shri C.D Singh has been exonerated of all the charges leveled against him.

4. AND WHEREAS Shri C.D Singh having been exonerated of all the charges leveled against him vide order dated 16.12.2010, the sealed covers containing the findings of the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forest Service held on 4.9.2009 and 25.11.2010 were opened on 16.2.2012 and it has been found that the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forest Service have found Shri C.D Singh " fit for promotion" to the grade of Chief Conservator of Forests as well as for grant of Non-functional up gradation.

5. **AND THEREFORE**, after considering the findings of the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forests Service; as arrived at in its meeting held on 4.9.2009 and 25.11.2010 kept in the sealed covers, the competent authority has decided to promote him to the grade of Chief Conservator of Forests in the Pay Band 4 (Rs. 37,400- Rs. 67,000/- + GP: Rs. 10,000) w.e.f the date of assumption of charge of CCF by Smt. N. Kala, IFS (AGMUT: 87) his junior in the cadre, who was promoted vide office order dated 9.12.2009 as CCF. Shri C.D Singh is also granted non-functional up gradation in Pay Band 4 (Rs. 37,400- Rs. 67,000/- + GP: Rs. 10,000) with effect from 18.2.2009 i.e. the date of grant of non-functional up gradation to Dr. A.K Ambasht, IFS (AGMUT: 87) who is immediate junior to him in the cadre vide order dated 13.12.2010.

6. Shri C.D Singh is posted to Arunachal Pradesh as CCF.
