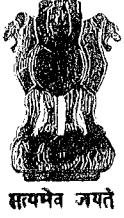
Sir/Madam,

As you may be aware, the Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH) is the technical and advisory arm of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG), which is mandated to ensure sound management of petroleum and natural gas resources with due regard for environment, safety, technological, and economic aspects.

2. Recognizing the importance of environment-related matters in the E&P Sector, the post of Additional Director General (Environment & Clearances) in DGH was being held by a senior officer (Level 14) of the Indian Forest Service. However, following the repatriation of the incumbent in May 2022, the post is lying vacant and the MoEF&CC, despite diligent efforts, has encountered challenges in identifying suitable senior IFoS officers for this post.

3. Recognizing the evolving landscape of environmental responsibilities, including the imperative of addressing emerging concerns such as Carbon Capture, Utilization, and Storage (CCUS), rigorous enforcement of Site Restoration Guidelines, and expediting pending statutory clearances, it is imperative that we secure capable leadership in the Environment and Clearance Department at DGH.

4. The issue was discussed in the Administrative Council Meeting of the DGH headed by Secretary, MoPNG in February 2024 and it was decided that DGH may, for now, operate the post of Head of Department (Environment) at level 13 of the Pay Matrix and appoint officers from the Indian Forest Service (IFoS) currently serving at Level 12/13 (Deputy Secretary/Director level) to serve in DGH.

5. In view of the above, I would like to request you for the nomination of a suitable IFoS officer at Level 12/13 for appointment as Head of Department (Environment) on deputation basis in DGH, for a period of three years, extendable by two years.
