

3. In this regard, your kind attention is drawn to the Note below rules 12 of Regulations relating to Physical Examination of candidates contained in Appendix III of Rule 18 of IFS Examination Rules, 2019 which inter alia reads as: -

“.....Walking test: The male candidate (both PH and non-PH) will be required to qualify in walking test of 25 kilometers to be completed in 4 hours and female candidates (both PH and non-PH) 14 kilometers to be completed in 4 hours. The arrangement for conducting this test will be made by the Director General of Forests, Government of India so as to synchronize with the sitting of the Medical Board.

Provided in case a candidate either fails to complete the walking test within the prescribed time limit or fails to appear in the test, will be given another opportunity to appear in the walking test. In case he/she again fails to appear/pass the test, no further opportunity will be given to him/her to appear in the walking test.”
