
Sub: One time relaxation for filing missing Annual Immovable Property Return (AIPR) off-line for the year 2022 (as on 01.01.2023) – for the IFS officers – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the amendment carried out in the AIS (Pay) Rules, 2016 vide Notification dated 30.12.2021 which inter-alia made it mandatory for officers to file IPR and to state that **an opportunity is being provided as a one time measure to all the IFoS officers who have missed out filing their IPR on-line as on 31.01.2023 to file their IPR off-line for the year 2022 (as on 01.01.2023) w.e.f, 01.07.2023 to 31.08.2023.**

2. In view of above, all the concerned IFoS officers are requested to kindly forward **their missing IPR (Off-line) through concerned State Govt//UTs/offices w.e.f. 01.07.2023 to 31.08.2023**
