Subject: Offer of appointment in respect of Smt. Bharati, IFS (SK:1992) to the post of Inspector General of Forests (IGF), Department of Land Resources, Ministry of Rural Development, New Delhi on deputation basis under Central Staffing Scheme of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change(CSS-MoEFCC)-regarding.

Madam,

I am directed to refer to your application dated 12.04.2019 for appointment to the post of Inspector General of Forests (IGF) on deputation basis under Central Staffing Scheme of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change(CSS-MoEFCC) and to inform that Appointments Committee of the Cabinet(ACC) has approved the appointment of Smt. Bharati, IFS(SK:1992) to the post of Inspector General of Forests in Level 14 of the Pay Matrix (by upgrading one of the existing two posts of Deputy Inspector General of Forests(DIGF)) and shifting the same to MoEF&CC on tenure deputation basis, under Central Staffing Scheme of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (CSS-MoEFCC) on the following terms and conditions:

- (i) She will draw pay as per the scale allowed by the Cadre Controlling Authority plus Allowances as applicable to that grade.
- (ii) The central deputation tenure of the officer will be up to 13.02.2021 (maximum tenure of 07 years outside cadre), or until further order, whichever is earlier.
- (iii) The headquarters of the post will be at New Delhi however the services of the officer can be utilized anywhere in India.
- (iv) Other terms and conditions will be the same as applicable to the other officers of her grade on deputation to the Central Government and as per CSS-MoEFCC.

2. The upgraded post of Deputy Inspector General of Forests, Department of Land Resources, Ministry of Rural development against which Smt. Bharati, IFS(SK:1992) will be appointed as Inspector General of Forests is also shifted to MoEF&CC.

3. In this regard, it is requested to join the above post at New Delhi at the earliest.
