Order

On the basis of recommendation of the RSCM held on 01.08.2023, name of Sh. Mahesh Chandra Kalita, IFS (Retd.) (DOB: 01.03.1958) was included in the Select List 2010 from 2012(earlier) in compliance of the order dated 20.11.2017 of the Hon'ble CAT, Guwahati Bench in OA no. 40/411/2016.

2. In terms of the provisions contained in Rule 3(3)(ii) & Rule 4 of IFS (Regulation of Seniority) Rules, 1997, as amended from time to time, the year of allotment of the following SFS officer of Assam segment of Assam-Meghalaya Joint Cadre, who was appointed as IFS officers in Assam against the Select List 2012 now amended to 2010 is re-determined as under:

And in terms of rule 3(3)(ii) of IFS (Regulation of Seniority) Rules, 1977, The year of allotment of a promotee officer shall be determined with reference [year for which] the meeting of the Committee to make selection, to prepare the select list on the basis of which he was appointed to the Service, was held and up to the 31 st day of December of the year immediately before the [year for which] meeting of the Committee to make selection was held to prepare the select list on the basis of which he was appointed to the Service.

* For the purpose of calculation of the weightage, the fractions, if any, are to be ignored.

3. In terms of rule 5(3) of IFS(Pay) Rules, 2016, the initial pay of a State Forest Service officer, on his appointment to the Service or on appointment in a

cadre post in an officiating capacity in accordance with rule 9 of the Indian Forest Service (Cadre) Rules, 1966, as the case may be, shall be fixed as per the principles laid down in Schedule I annexed to above rule and the pay and incremental benefits shall accrue to him under the relevant provisions. Accordingly, the State Government is requested to take further necessary action.
