Sub: Proposal for "Training of Personnel of Other Services" for the year 2023-24 under the scheme "Forestry Training and Capacity Building" –reg

Sir,

As you are aware that the Ministry is implementing a scheme on "Forestry Training and Capacity Building" which aims to cover the whole gamut of the training and exposure needs of the forestry sector personnel as well as members of the civic society in the country.


2. The component "**Training of Personnel of Other Services**" is a new component of the scheme through which short-term triannng, workshops and study tours are undertaken. The officials may include both development and regulatory sector represented by personnel of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary, Tribal, DRDA, Rural, Public Health, Irrigation, Soil Conservation, Tourism departments, Revenue administration, Police Administration (DSPs/Sis), Judicial Officers at appropriate level. The Officials of forest departments are not covered in this component. The trainings for the class II/class III state level officers can be organized at the State ATIs/Forest Training Institutes etc.

3. The approved rates (**applicable from the financial year 2022-23**) for conducting the training course are as under: -
