As you are aware that the Ministry is implementing a scheme on "**Forestry Training and Capacity Building**" which aims to cover the whole gamut of the training and exposure needs of the forestry sector personnel as well as members of the civic society in the country.

2. One of the component of the scheme is "**Training of Other Stakeholders**" which provides specially designed short-term courses, study tours, workshops and seminars on various aspects of forest and environmental conservation organized/sponsored for various stakeholder which includes NGOs, students from educational institutions, nature clubs/eco-clubs, Panchayats, elected representatives, personnel from banking institutions, social activists, press and media persons etc., for two-three days arranged by the various institutions under the schemes.
