Sub: Nominations of Indian Forest Service officers for appointment to the post of Director, Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy (IGNFA) in Apex Scale of Rs. 80000 on tenure deputation basis covered under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry of Environment and Forests - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Environment and Forests invites nominations of eligible and willing IFS officers for appointment against the post of **Director, Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy (IGNFA), Dehradun in Apex Scale of 80000** under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry for the year 2012.

2. The criteria of eligibility laid down in the revised CSS-MoEF of dated 6th May,2011 for holding the post of DGF&SS & equivalent level are as under:-


- (i) Minimum 30 years of service with reference to the Year of Allotment in the IFS.
- (ii) At least one officer of the service of any state cadre, having the same year of allotment should have been completed two years of service to a post in Pay Band HAG + (i.e Rs.75500-80000).
(Explanatory notes:- It is not necessary for the officer under consideration to be actually appointed in the pay band of HAG+ in his cadre. The officer will be eligible for consideration to this post as long as any one officer of his batch has completed two years of service in pay band HAG + i.e 75500 – 80000.)
- (iii) The officer under consideration should have a minimum of one year of service left before superannuation.

3. The minimum of 30 years of service will be in reference to **01.01.2012** and the minimum of one year of service left before superannuation will be counted from **01.03.2012**.

4. The State Governments are requested to forward the nominations of the willing officers, clear from vigilance angle and whose services can be spared. Officers who have completed one spell of central deputation may be considered for a further spell of central deputation only after they have completed the stipulated cooling off period on **01.03.2012**. It is clarified that the cooling off period is reckoned from the date the officer reports back to his/her cadre on completion of earlier deputation tenure.


5. If an officer selected for appointment fails to take up the central deputation assignment after the appointment is approved, he will attract a '**5 years debarment**' from central deputation including foreign deputation /foreign training/ foreign assignment etc.

6. The application complete in all respects as per Annexure-I and Annexure-II alongwith copy of updated Executive Records Sheet (available on the website www.ifs.nic.in), vigilance clearance and concurrence of the state government should be sent to the Director (IFS), Room No.503, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi- 110003 latest by **10th Oct, 2011**. Application received without the consent of the State/ UT government will not be entertained. Application received after the last date will also not be considered. The applicant may forward his/her application through online on IFS website www.ifs.nic.in. However, the application so forwarded will be eligible for consideration only after it has been received with the consent of the concerned State Government /UTs by 10th Oct, 2011.
