ORDER

No.14014/1/2011-AIS-I (part) dated 3rd May, 2013, if a State Forest Service Officer is appointed to IFS on the basis of Select List which has been prepared in accordance with the ratio laid-down by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and confirmed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Praveen Kumar's case, seniority rules as amended on 18/04/2012 will be applicable for year of allotment of the officer.
