

Minutes of the Meeting of the Screening Committee held on 30.11.2016 at 11:00 A.M. to prepare the "OFFER LIST" for APCCF level posts under the Central Staffing Scheme of M/o EF & CC

The Meeting of the Screening Committee for recommending names/panel for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" for appointment to the post of APCCF(C) at (i) Regional Office, Bhuvaneshwar (ii) Regional Office, Shillong, (iii) Regional Office, Chandigarh and (iv) Regional Office, Lucknow was held on 30.11.2016 in the chamber of Director General of Forests & Special Secretary, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Jor Bagh Road, New Delhi-3. 2. The Committee while considering the names for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" against the vacant/likely to fall vacant posts at the level of APCCF under the Central Staffing Scheme of M/o EF & CC, took into account their Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs)/ Personal Appraisal Reports (PARs) grading and other relevant records as well as the following and other eligibility conditions notified for the purpose for ascertaining their suitability:

- (a) For APCCF level posts at the Regional Offices of Bhuvaneshwar and Shillong, IFS Officers of 1985-87 batches are eligible and have a minimum of 03 years of service left before superannuation as on 01.01.2016. Crucial date for determining cooling-off period is 01.01.2016 as notified.
- (b) For APCCF level posts at the Regional Offices of Chandigarh and Lucknow, IFS Officers of 1985-87 batches are eligible and have a minimum of 03 years of service left before superannuation as on 01.01.2017. Crucial date for determining cooling-off period is 01.01.2017 as notified.

3. The Screening Committee also set the following criteria for inclusion of officers in "OFFER LIST":

- (i) Vigilance Clearance Certificate including Annual Property Return.
- (ii) Out of 72 marks (maximum) considering 8 ACRs/PARs, qualifying benchmark of 62 marks was fixed.
- (iii) At least 3 ACRs/PARs from the cut-off year out of 05 years immediately preceding the cut-off should be available. The committee considered ACRs starting from the year 2014-2015.

4. The Committee considered all application including advance copies. It was decided that in respect of advance copies, the respective applications should be received through proper channel in the Ministry/ before the meeting of the Special Selection Committee.

5. While considering applicants for APCCF level posts, the Screening Committee after due scrutiny of records, recommended the following names for inclusion in the "OFFER LIST" subject to vigilance clearance and timely submission of Immovable Property Returns for the year 2015.


