Sub: Short Notice Vacancy Circular for inviting nominations of Indian Forest Service officers for appointment to Forestry Posts at the level of IGF/DIGF/AIGF on tenure deputation basis under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change-regarding

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate invites nominations of eligible and willing IFS officers for appointment against the Forestry Posts at the level of IGF/DIGF/AIGF to prepare "OFFER LIST" for respective level posts for the year 2015, under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry Environment and Forests dated 06.05.2011. Details of vacant/likely to fall vacant posts are at **Annexure-III**.

2. As far as the eligibility of batches vis-a-vis the minimum years of service is concerned, it has been decided to invite the applications from the IFS officers of following batches for respective level posts. In addition to this, one year of overlap at DIGF and AIGF level will also be allowed, if the officer is willing for the post at the lower level.

3. The minimum years of service (for the respective post) will be with reference to **01.01.2015** and the minimum year of service left before superannuation will be counted from **01.01.2015**.

4. In addition to above, it is informed that as per provisions contained in para 4 of the Central Staffing Scheme of MoEF&CC dated 06.05.2011, in exceptional cases, where sufficient number of IFS officers are not available for the appointment to specific posts, the officers borne on the State Forest Service (SFS) whose names are included in the '**Select List**' referred to in Regulation 7(3) of the IFS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1966, shall also be considered for selection for appointment. In case of posts in the North Eastern Region, the SFS officer who are yet to be included in the '**Select List**' referred to above, shall also be considered **provided they have completed 08 years of service as on 01.01.2015**. This provision will however be applicable for **DIGF/AIGF** level posts only.

5. In view of the above, the State Governments are requested to forward the nominations of the willing officers, clear from vigilance angle and whose services can be spared. Officers who have completed one spell of central deputation may be considered for a further spell of central deputation only after they have completed the stipulated cooling off period on **01.01.2015**. It is clarified that the cooling off period is reckoned from the date the officer reports back to his/her cadre on completion of earlier deputation tenure.

6. If the officer selected for appointment fails to take up the central deputation assignment after the appointment is approved, he will attract a '**5 years debarment**' from central deputation including foreign deputation /foreign training/ foreign assignment etc.

7. The application complete in all respects as per Annexure-I and Annexure-II (available on the website www.ifs.nic.in, vigilance clearance, duly attested APARs (for the last eight years for IGF level posts) and duly attested APARS (for the last five years for DIGF/AIGF level posts) and concurrence of the State Government should be sent to the **Director (IFS-I), Jal Wing, 6th Floor, Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Jor Bagh Road, New Delhi- 110003** latest by 29.07.2015. For IFS officers of North East Cadre, who are in the Cadre, the last date of submission of application will be 13.08.2015. **It may also be ensured that the updated Executive Record Sheet of the applicant is also be attached with the application.**

8. Application received without the consent of the State /UT Government and after the last date of receipt of applications will not be entertained.

9. **The number of vacancies as mentioned in Annexure-III may increase or decrease at all levels.**

10. In most of the State Governments, Central Deputation Reserve (CDR) is highly undersubscribed therefore the State Governments are requested to nominate sufficient number of IFS officers to the CDR.
