Sub: Nominations of Indian Forest Service officers for appointment on tenure deputation basis to the following posts of IGFs/AIGFs in NTCA under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry of Environment and Forests - reg.

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Environment and Forests invites nominations of suitable IFS officers for appointment to the four posts of IGFs/AIGFs at following stations in NTCA under the Central Staffing Scheme of this Ministry:-

S.No	Name of the Post	Station	Pay Scale
1.	Inspector General of Forests – One Post*	Bangalore	PB-4 with G.P of Rs 10000/-
2.	Inspector General of Forests – One Post*	Nagpur	PB-4 with G.P of Rs 10000/-
3.	Assistant Inspector General of Forests – Two Posts*	New Delhi	PB-3 with G.P of Rs 6600/-, G.P Rs. 7600/- & PB-4 with G.P Rs. 8700/-

***No of posts may increase or decrease at all levels.**

2. The criteria of eligibility for holding the post of IGF (NTCA) are as under:-

- (a) (i) The officer should have at least 8 years of experience in wildlife conservation, out of which five years should be in tiger reserves or the National Tiger Conservation Authority/ Project Tiger Division of the Ministry;
- (ii) Holding analogous post on regular basis;
- (iii) Minimum 19 years of service with reference to the Year of Allotment in the IFS; and.
- (iv) The officer under consideration should have a minimum of 4 years of service left before superannuation.

- (b) Minimum of 19 years of service will be with reference to **01.01.2013** and the minimum of four years of service left before superannuation will be counted from **01.01.2013**.

3. The criteria for AIGFs level post are as under:

- (a) (i) holding analogues post on regular basis; or
- (ii) holding posts in the scale pay of Rs.10,000 – 15200 (Pre-revised) or equivalent with five year's regular service in the grade; and
- (b) having at least five years field experience in wildlife management .

4. The State Governments are requested to forward the nominations of eligible and the willing officers, clear from vigilance angle and whose services can be spared. Officers who have completed one spell of central deputation may be considered for a further spell of central deputation only after they have completed the stipulated cooling off period as on **15.07.2013**. It is clarified that the cooling off period is reckoned from the date the officer reports back to his/her cadre on completion of earlier deputation tenure.

5. If an officer selected for appointment fails to take up the central deputation assignment after his appointment is approved, he will attract a '**5 years debarment**' from central deputation including foreign deputation /foreign training/ foreign assignment etc.

6. The applications complete in all respects as per Annexure-I and Annexure-II alongwith copy of updated Executive Records Sheet (available on the website www.ifs.nic.in), vigilance clearance and concurrence of the state government should be sent to the Deputy Secretary (IFS-1), Room No.527, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi- 110003 latest by **15th July, 2013**. Applications received without the consent of the State/ UT government will not be entertained. Applications received after the last date will also not be considered. However, the competent authority may relax any of the conditions, if considered necessary to do so.
