Please refer to DO letter No. F.4/13/2010-AIS dated 22.02.2010 by Secretary, UPSC regarding convening of the meetings of the Selection Committee for promotion of SCS/SPS/SFS officers to the IAS/IPS/IFS before 31st of December in accordance with the provisions of the Promotion Regulations of the All India Services.
